They're the latest generation in a line of cannon-makers, who supplied the French army defending the region against the Prussians, during the Napoleonic Wars.

"We are artisanal, innovative, passionate and transparent. Contrary to industrial champagne houses, Frerejean Frères seeks to produce artisanal wines of champagne. When most brands age their wines in the cellars for 18 months and dose them highly, we have decided to let them rest for a minimum of 5 years in order to offer a transparent wine full of emotion. In this quest for quality, we go back to the origins to craft a wine of character.
